The presence of our special guest, mascot, the Monkey, made the event lively and filled with fun and frolic.








## ST INTERNATIONAL STUDENT'S EXCHANGE





STUDENT EXCHANGE In April 2021, the First International Student's Exchange was held, where children from countries such as Ecuador, Spain, Colombia, Guatemala, Mexico and Panama participated during their classes. This allowed visiting classmates from other countries and live the experience of knowing different typical games of the region to which they traveled, as well as characteristic speaking ways of the country.

The student winners of the ALOHA Rewards Online "travelled" virtually to one of the Spanish-speaking countries mentioned above during a class. The students enjoyed some of the most famous and representative games of the country they visited and also the use of certain words in their country were expressed as different idioms

while demonstrating everything they learned during their ALOHA classes.

Each country equipped its classes with dynamic presentations which included typical games befitting the students and activities with images and vivid music that set the little ones to participate and develop during the class and live with the guests of the different participating countries. Above all, respecting the original ALOHA class structure.





Spain made "Lottery" games where the little ones carried out operations and crossed out the results to win. They also created games such as "Guess Who" where the little ones imitated professions and animals so that others could guess what it was. The "Musical Chairs" was a perfect finishing touch since the little ones laughed between music to sit as soon as the music stopped.

In Ecuador, they played "Truth or Dare" wherein the students chose a number to be able to do challenges or to be able to answer questions. The "Hopscotch game" was part of the fun activity where the teacher showed a virtual Hopscotch and

dice to perform different challenges. Finally, in the game coined as "My boat is going to sail" students were asked to mention an object from the same semantic field making a large string of words.









With Colombia, the little ones played as a team to the "Trompo" in a roulette being in an icon to carry out the activity that was shown. The "Stop" game had modifications where the children drew the elements with the color that was mentioned by the teacher. They ended up with all the rhythm of the game "Statues" where the music flowed and when the music stopped, they had to freeze.

In Panama, they decided to play "Twister" through a roulette that contained the different icons of ALOHA activities. Depending on the color, the students would perform some action, such as the abacus, flashcards, mental oral, steps, fingering theory, or jump.





Students from all participating countries finished their exchange with a fun ALOHA Challenge competition. They tested their knowledge of classic films and the funniest cartoons, with a very entertaining competition full of laughter and a lot of emotion.











## ALOHA PRACTICE PLATFORM



ALOHA Mental Arithmetic continues to innovate day by day to offer delegates, teachers and students tools that allow them to strengthen daily practice in a more interactive and fun way. Now, it can be done through the new ALOHA Practice Platform.

The objective of this platform is to strengthen the knowledge acquired in class and the teachers in their profile can view the summary of the exercises performed by the students of the group every week.

Students can practice 12 weeks for each level, and each week contains 6 days of work. The "Board" can be worked in the class or at home and by performing the 80% of the calculations correctly for the week, the student gets entitled to crack the weekly Challenger.





The platform has four modes to practice: abacus, fingering theory (Kids), visualization of abacus and flashcards, as well as extra challenges from Super Kids or Super Tiny Tots.



In the teacher's profile, there will appear a summary of the exercises performed per week by the students in the group.



ALOHA Mental Arithmetic continues to generate strategies and add tools so that the experience of the students of the program continues to enrich them and provide them with lifetime benefits.

#### **BRAIN WORKSHOPS**



Workshops were devised for the students for their school holiday in which the essential characteristics of ALOHA Mental Arithmetic prevail: the abacus and the game. # ADVANTAGES OF BRAIN WORKSHOPS














• Fun guaranteed. The program is designed in such a way so that each workshop awakens the student's interest posing a constant challenge through fun and experimental activities.

Each workshop lasts one week in which, at the end of each day, there is an "intelligence challenge" that stimulates explicitly the benefit linked to the corresponding week. While doing these activities, different crafts and experiments are performed in turn helping the student to boost one of the multiple intelligence.

• Version 2: "Brain Workshops Travelling around the world". Each workshop lasts one week and is focused on a different country: Brazil, Mexico, China, Spain, France, India, England, and Russia. These workshops allow students to work on multiple intelligence and enhance ALOHA benefits while learning new and exciting things about each country, such as its culture, traditions and food through crafts, cold cooking activities, experiments, stories, and games.

And in Cambodia, Colombia, Ecuador, Guatemala, Ireland, Malaysia, Panama, and the Philippines, ALOHA classes continue 100% Online. While in Mexico, ALOHA is back with three modes of learning depending on the region, center and/or school.
